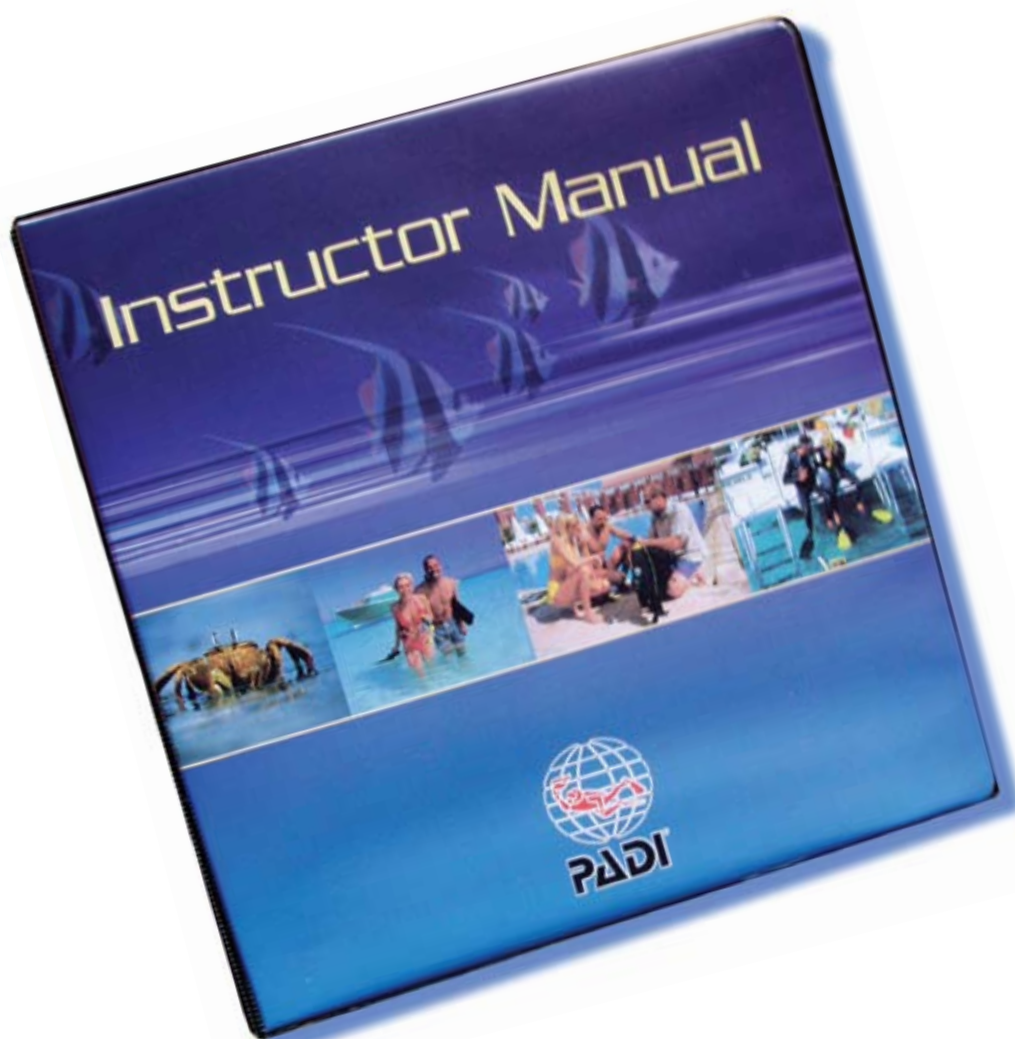
PADI INSTRUCTOR DEVELOPMENT COURSE INFORMATION

PADI instructors are the most sought after individuals in the dive industry and the PADI Instructor Development Course (IDC) defines the standard in instructor education.

During the IDC we will use PADI's extensive range of instructional materials, which support the most comprehensive instructor program in the industry. You will receive unparalleled support from our friendly and professional staff, who are dedicated to assisting you to succeed during your IDC, Instructor Examination (IE) and in your future, as a dive educator.

What is the PADI IDC and IE?

The PADI instructor development programme is split into 2 courses: the Assistant Instructor (AI) and the Open Water Scuba Instructor (OWSI), which can be completed independently or combined as the IDC. Both the AI and OWSI are developmental courses where the focus is placed on you learning and improving your new skills.

On both courses you will complete a varied curriculum of presentations, confined and open water workshops, discussions and candidate teaching presentations.

The AI course concentrates on PADI's educational philosophy and methodology and will help you to begin your development into a successful dive educator. You will learn how to teach in the classroom, confined and open water, in addition to covering the courses that Assistant Instructors can independently teach.

Upon successful completion of the AI course you can enrol onto the OWSI course.

The OWSI course further develops the teaching skills that you mastered on your AI course and introduces the entire PADI system of diver education. You will also complete presentations on marketing your diver programmes, the business of the dive industry, the law and the dive professional and teaching children. Through this multifaceted course you will be fully prepared to become a successful 'real world' dive educator.

Upon successful completion of your IDC you are eligible to attend the PADI IE, a 2-day evaluation of your skills and knowledge, conducted by PADI staff. Successful completion of the IE qualifies you as an Open Water Scuba Instructor.

At Deep Blue Scuba we are dedicated to ensuring that you succeed during your IDC, IE and as an instructor. We provide knowledge review sessions on; physics, physiology, decompression theory and the RDP and skill review sessions, prior to the start of the IDC. These sessions are provided FREE of charge. After completion of your course and IE our staff will be pleased to provide you with guidance and advice, on your career development.

Prerequisites

- **PADI Divemaster or Assistant Instructor or hold a leadership level qualification from another organisation**
- **Be 18 years of age or older**
- **Have proof or 60 logged dives (100 required by the start of the IE)**
- **Have been a certified diver for at least 6 months**
- **Be certified as an Emergency First Response instructor**
- **Have a medical, signed by a doctor, stating that you are fit to dive and completed within the last 12 months. If you are planning to teach in the UK you will need an HSE medical. Your medical must be valid up to the last day of the IE**

Course Structure

The AI course takes 4 days to complete and the OWSI course takes 5 days to complete. All components of the course, bar the open water dives, will take place in central Edinburgh.

Courses are scheduled to coincide with a UK IE so that the skills that you develop on your course will remain fresh, at the time of your IE. course dates can be found in the schedule at the foot of the Pro Courses page of this web site.

Related Courses

Having invested in your dive education you may choose to take this further. The Speciality Instructor courses allow you to earn additional money, learn new skills and to keep fresh. Having completed 5 Speciality Instructor courses and taught 25 students you are eligible to become a Master Scuba Diver Trainer (MSDT). Completion of the MSDT prep course allows you to complete 5 Speciality Instructor courses, which you are most likely to teach, at a slightly reduced cost. During this course you will receive invaluable hints and tips to allow you to run your courses as effectively as possible.

The IDC Staff Instructor course allows you to assist Course Directors to teach Instructor Development Courses and to independently teach the Assistant Instructor course.

The EFR Instructor course entitles you to teach the EFR primary and secondary care courses, which are required by most people to complete the Rescue Diver Course. This course can also be offered to all divers and non-divers as a modern, comprehensive first aid qualification. The Care for Children (CFC) course can be combined with the EFR course to provide additional expertise, specific to the younger patient.

During these courses we will use the most up to date training aids and mannequins and include the optional defibrillator use and emergency oxygen use skills.
