## MASTER SCUBA DIVER COURSE INFORMATION

**The Master Scuba Diver rating is not a course but a certification to recognise the very experienced recreational diver. This is the top, non-professional rating, within the PADI system of diver education and is only awarded to divers with a superior level of diving skills and experience of a number of specialist diving skills.**

To qualify to become a Master Scuba Diver you must be a Rescue Diver, hold 5 specialities and have completed a minimum of 50 logged dives.

When your MSD application is approved you will receive a new certification card showing your new diving status.

The PADI (Professional Association of Diving Instructors) certification is the most popular in the world and allows you to hire or purchase diving equipment, arrange diving and enrol on further training courses including the Divemaster course – to take your diving to the professional level by learning skills to assist with divers in training and to independently assist certified divers.

Deep Blue Scuba organises a number of UK and overseas dive trips and runs an active dive club (Deep Blue Scuba Adventures) to help you continue diving, after your course.

How old do I need to be?

You need to be at least 12 years old. If you are under 15 you will be awarded the Junior Master Scuba Diver rating. At 15 you can upgrade your certification.

How much does the PADI Master Scuba Diver rating cost?

The application fee, payable directly to PADI, is currently £27.03.
