PADI IDC STAFF INSTRUCTOR COURSE INFORMATION

The PADI IDC Staff Instructor Course provides Master Scuba Diver Trainers with the additional training necessary to staff PADI Instructor Development Programs. The course builds upon your experience as a dive educator while concentrating on developing evaluation and counseling skills.

PADI IDC Staff Instructors are able to:

- Independently teach and certify PADI Assistant Instructors.
- Conduct IDC training segments under the direct supervision of a PADI Course Director.
- Evaluate and critique instructor candidate knowledge development, confined water and open teaching presentations.
- Provide counseling and remedial training for instructor candidates and IDC Staff Instructor candidates.
- Assist with training during instructor level training programs such as PADI Specialty Instructor Training courses.
- Observe the orientation and closing sessions of PADI Instructor Examinations.

As a successful PADI diving instructor this rating will allow you to pass on your experience to aspiring instructors, gain new teaching skills while enhancing existing skills and remain fresh through your ability to teach a wider range of courses.

What are the course pre-requisites?

To enroll in your IDC Staff Instructor course you will need to be a teaching status PADI Instructor for the current year and hold a PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer Rating.

You must own a current and up to date Course Director Manual, a current and up to date Instructor Manual and current open water and confined water evaluation slates.

Any of these materials can be purchased directly from PADI or from Deep Blue Scuba at reduced rates (See right →).

How is the course scheduled?

You will complete a 2 day training and evaluation programme followed by auditing a complete IDC. Auditing the IDC allows you to apply and practice evaluation skills gained during the training and evaluation programme.

We can tailor the timing of the training and evaluation programme to suit your personal timescale but this programme would usually take place in the two days prior to one of our IDC's.

How much does the course cost?

The course costs £250.

Are there any additional costs?

Your application fee to PADI is not included in the price of the course. This is currently £73.03 and is payable directly to PADI, upon successful completion of your course.

The required materials are also not included in the cost of the course but can be purchased from Deep Blue Scuba at the reduced rates noted below:
